On February 17 our **GIFT** DVD series "Goliath" *Must* Fall" returns. February's topic examines the giant of rejection. Rejection is painful and can take different forms. Whether we are rejected for a prospective job or promotion; entrance into the college of our choice or any other number of reasons---rejection is painful! It is the rejection though of someone we are close to that dwarfs all the other forms. Just a few words, or the lack thereof, from a key person in our world such as a parent or spouse can shape how we view ourselves for our entire lives. The giant of rejection brings its cousins insecurity, inferiority, being driven by perfectionism or compulsiveness along with it. We need to break free from the clutches of rejection.
