Did You Know?

Every Vestry meeting starts with a Bible reading followed by questions and discussion related to the Scripture just read, spanning 15 minutes or so. In our June meeting we read from The Passion Translation of Proverbs 16:1-4, 9, "Go ahead and make all the plans you want, but it's the Lord who will ultimately direct your steps. We are all in love with our own opinions, convinced they're correct. But the Lord is in the midst of us, testing and probing our every motive. Before you do anything, put your trust totally in God and not in yourself. Then every plan you make will succeed. The Lord works everything together to accomplish his purpose. Even the wicked are included in his plans – he sets them aside for the day of disaster. Within your heart you can make plans for your future, but the Lord chooses the steps you take to get there."

These proverbs and passages all address the theme of God's sovereignty over human affairs. A person may plan words or actions in her/his heart, but what actually happens is from the Lord. Nothing that a person plans to do can come to pass apart from God's sovereign will. We then discussed what opinions do we have that we're convinced are correct about intercessory prayer, healing ministries, music at Advent, Advent's future, and church growth? Which of our motives is He probing and testing? In all these matters, we are striving to put our trust totally in God and not in ourselves. We make plans but God chooses the steps to get there if the "there" is in accordance with His will.
